**Annual Report 2020-21**

During the academic year 2020-21, the college has contributed significantly for institutionalizing the quality assurance strategies and processes as follows,

- Five faculty members were actively participated in Board of Studies.
- Four new self-designed add on courses were organized for the students.
- Three research students bagged fellowships from SARTHI and BARTI.
- Miss Supriya Kuasale, research student of Microbiology department bagged second prize in 'Anveshan'- National students research convention.
- Total 24 online, offline webinars (10), workshops (14) were in the college.
- Online certificate courses were made available for students through registration on Coursera-college campus and paid membership of Spoken Tutorial, IIT, Powai.
- Total number of conferences, seminars attended by faculty members is 113.
- 22 research papers were published by faculty and research students in reputed international and national journals.
- Dr. P. U. Lande, Department of Electronics, received two copyrights.
- 121 students have received Rajashri Chatrapati Shahu Maharaj Shikshan Shulk Shishyavrutti scheme scholarship from Maharashtra government.
- Total four programs were organised for faculty including two workshops for e-Content development.
- Total 12 faculty members participated in different faculty development programmes.
- The college gives special focus on coaching for competitive examinations, career and personal counselling.
- 140 students progress to higher education through succeeding entrance examinations.
- Various activities were conducted by departmental clubs, like, Covide awareness programme, AAJ KAL aur AAJ guidance programme by alumina, Preparation of household Chemicals, Instrumental Techniques in Pharmaceutical Laboratories', Chemistry student conference-2021, E- Mobile Photography Competition and programme on Bird diversity in Campus.
- Online feedback from various stockholders were collected and analysed.
- Total 8 new MoU's were signed by the college.
- As a part of institutional social responsibility various programmes were organised, like, plantation drive, waste management, water conservation, blood, cloths and food donation, anti-plastic awareness, polio awareness campaign, *Swaccha Bharat abhiyan*, old age home visit, oxygen park development through NCC, NSS and NGOs.
- Alumni association contributed for maintenance of oxygen park and donated plant samplings.
- The grants received from DPC (Rs. 12255702/-), Plan (Rs. 60000/-) and Non Plan (Rs. 4877361/-) from state Government and Shivaji University, Kolhapur (Lead college activity 36000/-) were successfully utilized for college development.
